

FLFD LEGACY COMMITTEE

The “A Legacy for Our Future” Committee launched the Legacy Capital Campaign at the Forest Lakes Fire District Open House June 27th 2015.

The goal of the “A Legacy for Our Future” Committee was to raise capital funds to build a new fire station. The “A Legacy for Our Future” Committee evolved when two local citizens, Susie Bragg and John Fahrendorf, volunteered their services to take on the challenge of the capital campaign effort. In 2016 they were succeeded by Jon Waggoner, FLFD Board Member. The committee has been renamed “FLFD Legacy Committee” and the campaign is known as “LEGACY”. Jon Waggoner has since left the FLFD Board and the Legacy Committee now reports to the FLFD Finance Committee.
